Summary Report on the Status

Of Implementation of Resolutions Adopted by the 35th AIPA General Assembly

The 35th AIPA General Assembly adopted 12 resolutions, out of which the Lao National Assembly have directly implemented 5 resolutions by translating them into national legislation. In addition, other resolutions have been implemented more or less in other forms such as policies, regulation and projects of concerned government agencies at central and local levels.

Res.35GA/2014/POL/01 Resolution on Parliamentary Cooperation in the ASEAN Political- Security Community	This resolution has been implemented through actual exchange of discussion, visits and consultation with parliaments of ASEAN member countries in order to enhance mutual understanding, cooperation and support as well as to contribute to creating the climate of peace and security in the region. Such activities have been carried out by different levels of the Lao parliamentary delegations, including

Res.35GA/2014/ECO/02 Resolution on promoting the development of entrepreneurship in the process of narrowing development gaps in ASEAN	In connection with this resolution, the National Assembly of the Lao PDR has recently (July 2015) adopted a Law on Business Competition in order to create enabling environment for free and fair competition among enterprises in the country as well as for them to better engage in the ASEAN Economic Community, by way contributing to narrowing development gaps in ASEAN.

Res.35GA/2014/SOC/02 Resolution on Enhancing Legislative Cooperation among AIPA member Parliaments on Prevention and Control of Non-Communicable Diseases	In November 2014, the National Assembly adopted an amendment of the Law on Health Care on order to make it relevant with the new condition. The amendment laid out greater details on rights and responsibility of parties involves in health care services and measures to prevent and control the spreading of non-Communicable Diseases
Res.35GA/2014/SOC/03 Resolution the Strengthening Parliamentary Role in Developing Vocational Education and Skilled Labour for Integration of ASEAN Labour Market	In July 2015, the National Assembly made an amendment to the Law on Education with more emphasis on Vocational Education which is consistent with country's industrialisation and modernization policies, at the same time to cater for the integration of the ASEAN Labour Market.
Res.35GA/2014/WAIPA/01 Resolution on strengthening Efforts in the Prevention of All Forms of Discrimination and Violence Against Women and Children	In lie with this AIPA resolution, in November 2014, The National Assembly of adopted a new Law on the Prevention of Violence against Women and Children
